\* *This is presented by Able Seaman Ransom of HMS Pickle (the ship that brought the news of Trafalgar back to Britain) and powder monkey Shiers of HMS Victory, both in 1805 seaman's dress. After looking at the risks Nelson took it looks at the mathematics of cannon balls and demonstrates their destructive power. 200 year old cannon balls are used. Probability using crown and anchor dice is looked at. We finish off by making an old piece of navigational instrumentation (parallel rulers) and the young people work on a navigational chart with the instrument made. This is accompanied by many worksheets to take away, answers and even a taste of ships biscuits. CD-ROMs of all the materials (and much more) are available for teachers to use in their classrooms.*
